

ORDINANCE NO. 1215

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING SECTION 3.04.050. OF THE  
TORRINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE, 2019 REVISIONS, RELATING TO  
SANITATION FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRINGTON, WYOMING:

**Section 1:** That Section 3.04.050. of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Torrington, Wyoming, 2019 Revisions, be and it is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

**Sec. 3.04.050. - Sanitation fees.**

The City shall charge the following fees for sanitation service:

A. *Sanitation Collection Fees.*

1. *Residential.* \$30.00 per month. Service will be one day a week throughout the year subject to additional collection as determined by the sanitation department supervisor.
2. *Commercial/Industrial.*
  - a) Small commercial service will be one day a week. \$58.50 per bin per month.
  - b) Medium commercial service will be three days per week. \$104.00 per bin per month.
  - c) Large commercial/restaurant service will be six days a week. \$201.50 per bin per month.
  - d) Industrial service will be once per month for 20 cubic yard roll off. \$390.00 per 20 cubic yard roll off per month, extra service will cost \$390.00 per service.
3. The fees in Section 3.04.050. A. will incur a 3% annual inflation increase every year on January 1st following the adoption of this ordinance. The first inflation increase will be effective January 1, 2020.

B. *Roll off containers.*

All roll offs shall be covered for transporting to the landfill and therefore all roll offs shall only be filled even with the top of the container. Any material extending over the top of the container shall be subject to the overfill fee set forth below.

1. Fee per cubic yards:

2. **Contracts.**

All customers using any of the roll-offs, shall first complete and sign the Contract for Account that is available at City Hall.

**C. Grass Bins.** \$130.00 per bin per month. Service will be three days per week.

1. All commercial (for hire) lawn service providers (seasonal full-time) shall be charged \$130.00 per month in the event they use the grass bins instead of hauling the grass to the baler. All grass delivered to the baler shall be free of charge. Keys to the baler will be issued upon application by the authorized individual at City Hall.

**D. Major appliances.** \$20.00 each for all major appliances, but not limited to, "white goods", refrigerators, stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, water heater and water softeners. All cooling fluids/chemicals shall be removed and the appliance shall be tagged.

**E. Additional pickup.** Customer requests for any pickup in addition to scheduled service shall be \$50.00 per load plus \$15.00 per cubic yard.

**F. Tires.** Tires shall be charged at current market rate of disposal based upon size of tire.

**G. Baler tipping.**

1. *City residents.* \$15.00 per cubic yard
2. *Not city residents.* \$20.00 per cubic yard
3. *Contractors.* \$75.00 per cubic yard for construction debris other than concrete, asphalt, block and brick.
  - a) Concrete, asphalt, block and brick: \$32.50 per pickup load or small trailer;
  - b) Concrete, asphalt, block and brick: \$65.00 per load for a single axle vehicle over 8600 GVW;
  - c) Concrete, asphalt, block and brick: \$97.50 per load for a double axle vehicle;
  - d) Concrete, asphalt, block and brick: \$130.00 per load for a semi-truck/trailer.
4. The fees in Section 3.04.050. G. will incur a 3% annual inflation increase every year on January 1st following the adoption of this ordinance. The first inflation increase will be effective January 1, 2020.

**H. Landfill tipping.**

1. *City residents.* \$23.00 fee for up to 1,000 pounds and 2.0 cents per pound thereafter.
2. *Not city residents.* \$39.00 fee for up to 1,000 pounds and 3.0 cents per pound thereafter.
3. *Contractors.* \$75.00 fee for up to 2,000 pounds and 3.0 cents per pound thereafter for construction debris other than concrete, asphalt, block and brick.

4. The fees in Section 3.04.050. H. will incur a 3% annual inflation increase every year on January 1st following the adoption of this ordinance. The first inflation increase will be effective January 1, 2020.

*I. Wood chips for sale.*

1. \$50.00 per pickup load.
2. \$6.00 per 40 lb. bag.

*J. Compost for sale. \$40.00 per three and one-half yards.*

*K. Crushed Concrete/Crushed asphalt (unless contracted separately) for sale.*

1. Cost of production plus \$3.00 per cubic yard.
2. If delivered by city forces, a material delivery charge of \$100.00 per hour shall be charged with a minimum one hour charge of \$100.00.

*L. Grass. No charge for city residents if taken to the baler facility.*

*M. Trees and limbs delivered to the baler.*

1. No charge for City residents.
2. Commercial tree trimmers/arborists shall be charged \$25.00 per load.
3. Storm damaged trees that require pickup by the City shall be charged \$50.00 to the property owner.

*N. Other Vendors. The city shall provide roll off containers to customers outside of the city limits. Other vendors shall be permitted to provide roll off containers only, to customers in the city limits.*

*O. Recycle Service Fees and Rules for Recycle Material.*

1. Recycle Center

- a) There will be no charge for material delivered to the recycling center.
- b) Material delivered to the recycling center must be sorted and placed in appropriate recycle bins.
- c) All material must be in a useful state for recycling purposes.
- d) No garbage will be accepted and violators will be subject to littering fines as established by ordinance.

2. Within City Limits

- a) Scheduled removal services for recycle material 10 cubic yards (1 recycle trailer) or less will be \$25.00.
- b) There will be a minimum charge of \$20.00 per service requested for 5 cubic yards or less.

3. Outside City Limits

- a) Scheduled removal services for recycle material 10 cubic yards (1 recycle trailer) or less will be \$25.00 plus \$0.55 per mile, round trip, from the recycling center.

4. Material

- a) Recycle material must be placed in areas accessible for small trucks and trailers.
- b) Cardboard for recycling must be broken down to a flat position.


- c) Cans for recycling must be in bags or in suitable storage containers.
- d) Plastics for recycling must be in bags or in suitable containers.
- e) Paper for recycling must be in bags, baled or in suitable containers.
- f) Glass will not be accepted.
- g) No material will be accepted if mixed with other material, not in an approved container, or not in a useful condition.

**Section 2:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.

Passed and approved on second reading the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2019.

Passed and approved on third and final reading the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2019.
